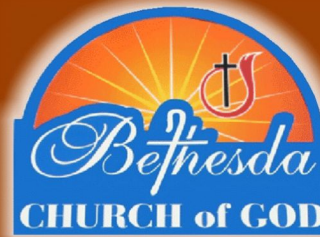

STRONG THREADS: Join other couples to study "Boundaries In Marriage" on Wednesdays at 7:00 pm class room 101!

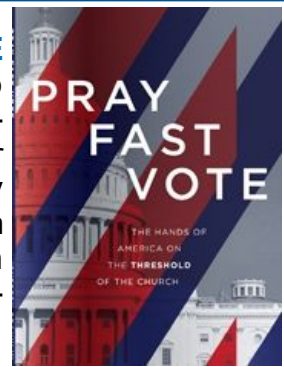
DRAMA PRACTICE: Will be Monday (Angels), and Thursday (Everyone—Review) at 6:45 pm this week.
