10AM PRAYER: has changed locations from the Bethesda Vineyard Bookstore to Room 114.

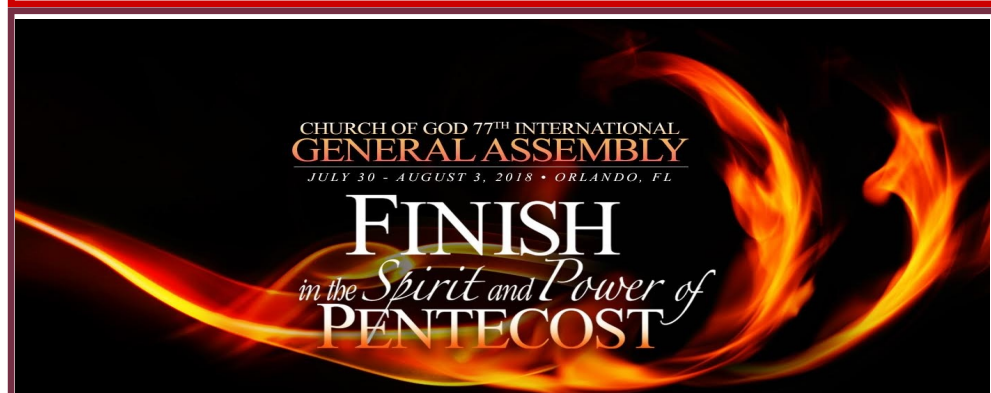
