**MOBILE-CLOTHES MINISTRY:** We are collecting clean, pressed, good condition clothing on hangers to be distributed to those less fortunate.

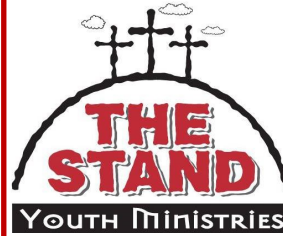
